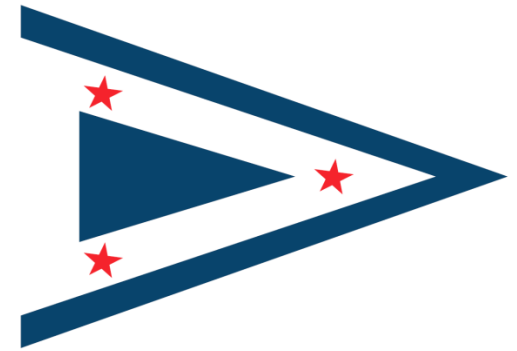

- Cruise with us: from weekend to week-long cruises with numerous social events along the way.

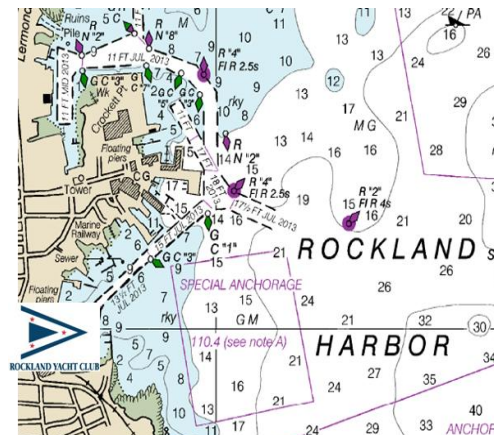


- Participate in our meetings throughout the year - they include invited marine professionals and Club members sharing their nautical adventures and achievements.
